SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

SANCTIONS #. 05-RS-41-P , 05-RS-42-P

RULES: This event is governed by the 2005 General Competition Rules and the category specifications as amended by any subsequent racing bulletins published in SPORTSCAR during the year and the South Atlantic Road Racing Championship Rules (2005) and the CCPS Rules (2005).

TRANSPONDERS by AMB are required for this event. All cars must have AMB Transponder installed before entering the track for their first session. If you do not have a Transponder, please contact Safe Quip Racing Products.

ENTRY FORMS: Entry Form must be completed and mailed to Wanda Cecil 1040 Slatestone Trail, Columbia, SC 29203. Phone: (803) 714-9797 Fax: (803) 714-9797. Entries postmarked after August 2, 2005 will be charged a late entry fee of \$50.00. Make checks payable to SCR SCCA. Checks will not be returned, if you do not show, they will be shredded. A \$50 charge will be assessed for any returned checks. U. S. funds only. No calls after 10:00 p.m.

OVERSUBSCRIPTION: In the event that the number of entries exceed the maximum number of cars allowed to start in a race the following will occur. Each competing driver/car combination shall qualify within a maximum of 120% of the qualifying time of the fastest qualifier in his/her class in order to be permitted to start the race unless waived by the Series Chief Steward or Series Operating Steward.

CAR NUMBERS and DECALS: SEDIV permanent numbers will be assigned upon acceptance of entry until the date of August 1, 2005. Numbers, class designations and decals shall be placed and sized per the GCR. And SARRC/CCPS series decals must be displayed on the cars Per the series rules. SARRC drivers must wear SARRC patches per series rules.

PASSES: Each entry is entitled to four passes. Only SCCA members will be issued crew passes. Current membership cards must be presented at registration in order to enter the facility. Members and race staff may be issued one guest pass.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented to all SARRC, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places, at the Hospitality Tent when cars are released from impound. Classes with protests will not be awarded until the protest is resolved. No trophies will be mailed.

RESULTS: Qualifying and race provisional results will be posted on the bulletin board outside the timing building. You will also be able to download the results from the SEDIV's Web Site, www.sediv racing.org. When a driver and, or car is excluded and, or disqualified, all others below him or her in class will move up one finishing position.

GATE HOURS: The gate will be manned from 7:00 p.m. Friday, August 12, 2005 to 7:00 p.m. Sunday, August 14, 2005. Entry will only be permitted with the presentation of the gate pass issued at registration. *Any SCCA Member arriving at the track before or after the listed registration hours may be allowed to enter the track upon signing a track waiver, and at the discretion of the CMP security personnel. Any individual entering in this manner must return to registration at the next registration hours before being allowed to participate in any part of the weekend. Driver or crew not properly SCCA registered will be ejected from the track without refund.*

SCALES: Scales will be open for competitors until 30 minutes before the race on Saturday and Sunday. Scales are located in the Tech Shed.

COMMUNICATIONS: Race staff uses 151.625, 151.805, MHz. Do not use these frequencies for personal or race communication. Violators will be removed from the facility.

START/FINISH: THE START LINE FOR ALL STARTS AND RESTARTS WILL BE ON THE BACK STRAIGHT NEAR STATION 9 (BEFORE THE KINK). THE NORMAL FINISH LINE WILL BE UTILIZED. Crossing of the normal finish line will constitute the completion of each lap. As a result of using the back straight start line, the first scored racing lap will run at pace speed until the green flag is displayed near turn 9. In the event of a wave off on the first racing lap, the grid will continue at pace speed until the green flag is displayed by the starter.

BLACK & CHECKED FLAG: The black flag will be shown at finish line and/or at Turn 9 with a number board. The checkered flag is located at finish line. For practice and qualifying sessions, the checkered flag will also be displayed at Turn 9. Please be aware of the pit out blend line that leads directly into turn one. When exiting the pits, cars must stay left of this line. Violators may be given a stop and go penalty. If your car stops on course for any reason it will be moved to a safe place and may be towed in after every other session to save time.

IMPOUND: After the finish of each race the top 3 cars of each class must report to impound and be weighed.

PITS AND PADDOCK: Long pants, closed toed shoes and sleeved shirts are required to cross pit wall. Keep all driveways clear for use by emergency vehicles. Only people with valid driver's licenses may operate pit support vehicles and at the discretion of CMP officials and the Chief Steward. Observe the speed limit of 10 MPH. No fireworks, firearms, weapons or illegal drugs are permitted anywhere on the premises. Animals must be on a leash at all times. The track requires each entrant to have in his or her paddock area, one (1) portable, dry chemical fire extinguisher of the rating of 10 BC. **Please keep children away from the lake.**

FACILITIES: Carolina Motorsports Park is an SCCA approved 2.235 mile road course. Water, air and electricity are available in the paddock. RV hook-ups are not available. Toilets and showers are available Oil dump stations are available. Race fuel is available at the track.

THERE WIL BE NO PREGRIDDING ON PADDOCK ROADS TO MAINTAIN SAFTY AND RESCUE ACCESS.

NO RACE ENGINES MAY BE RUN BETWEEN 8:00 P.M. AND 7:30 A.M. EACH DAY OR SUNDAY BETWEEN 11:00 A.M. AND 12:00 NOON.
